

In alignment with his work on the Senate Committee on Environment and Public Works, where he helps lead the fight to address the climate change crisis, in 2022 Senator Carper toured the Goodwill Recycling Center in New Castle, Delaware lending support to the advancement of Goodwill's sustainability and workforce development initiatives.

Achiever of the Year Award Amanda Favazza

Our Achiever of the Year Award honors an outstanding person with a disability or other disadvantaging condition who has shown great progress and accomplishment in overcoming barriers to employment, while receiving services to support employment in the community.

Despite being turned away from multiple career opportunities, in 2021 Amanda's tenacity led her to a Goodwill job fair where she secured a position (through Goodwill Staffing Services) as an Administrative Specialist supporting Volunteer Delaware 50+ a program of the State Office of Volunteerism under the Delaware Department of Health and Social Services. She also enrolled in the Goodwill Employment Support program which helps people with disabilities thrive in their jobs.

We celebrate Amanda's growth, optimism, talent and appreciation for the independence afforded her by work – the driving forces behind her success!



Arline Docherty Team Member of the Year Award Maria Deluna

Named for Goodwill team member Arline Docherty in 2019, this award recognizes a Goodwill team member who exemplifies the mission of Goodwill and displays the values of unselfish service to people with disabilities or other disadvantaging conditions.

Maria is a Production Associate on the Goodwill retail team and was nominated by her manager, who cited Maria's top performance in the store and her dedication as a valued mentor and trainer of her colleagues.

Maria, who speaks English as a second language, doesn't allow language to impeded her ability to connect with customers or her colleagues. She goes above and beyond to provide her colleagues with support, guidance and help learning their roles. In the process she's even inspired several colleagues to learn Spanish to better communicate with her.

In December of this year Maria will celebrate 20 years of employment with Goodwill – and today we celebrate Maria for embodying the Goodwill mission!
